

# NEW APARTMENT COMPLEX SCORES WITH CENTRAL ROOFING

f you're a soccer lover, there's no better place to live in the St. Paul area than next to Allianz Field, home to the Minnesota United FC, an American professional soccer club. With 160 units, the newly-constructed The Pitch apartment community fulfills that desire. It's literally right across the street from the 19,400-seat soccer stadium.

The location of The Pitch required significant district planning work. A previous building was demolished so that the new multi-use apartment complex could be created. Even with the new construction, construction challenges abounded, especially for the roof.

The team at UrbanWorks Architecture specified a Johns Manville 60-Mil non-reinforcing EPDM membrane, Johns Manville Energy 3 Insulation, plus a Johns Manville Vapor Barrier SA and Primer. Finally, a roof hatch was required plus sheet metal flashing and trim.

To top off this very special six-story apartment structure, Frana Companies brought in Central Roofing Companies. "Central Roofing consistently offers quality work at a competitive price," says Colin Pechacek, project manager with Frana Companies. "Their responsiveness and service levels on this project in particular were very good."

#### RECONFIGURING MERCY HOSPITAL

ack in 2017, Allina Health Mercy Hospital had a problem. The Minnesota health care location had simply run out of space. The solution involved relocating and enlarging the main entrance, reconfiguring the hospital's interior and adding a parking garage.

Four different roof plans were created for the new structure. On and off, it took Central Roofing almost three years to complete the roofing work.

"We hired Central Roofing Company to connect the older roofing sections with the new roof areas," says Rodney Sessing, senior superintendent at Knutson Construction. "We've worked with Central Roofing in the past on a variety of other projects. We had confidence their crews and service teams were the perfect fit for this project.

"During the scope of this project there must have been at least 100 new openings made in existing roofs. Central Roofing was there for each one of them and did a great job."

According to the project architect, the challenging venture benefited from the roofing solutions offered by the Central Roofing team. "The roof was critical to this project," says Isaac Bros, AIA, NCARB, project architect with HDR's Minneapolis Studio. "Tying new and old roof elements to the hospital harmoniously was tricky and vital. The roof needed to maintain the proper drainage, expansion and contraction — all while meeting the latest energy codes. Central Roofing reworked the drainage to provide a better solution for the hospital long term."



# UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA GOES BACK TO SCHOOL WITH ROOFING PREVENTIVE INSPECTION PROGRAM

ince 2014, the University of Minnesota Twin Cities has contracted Central Roofing to assure that the 280 roofs on their campus structures stay in "Grade A" condition. Central Roofing's Preventative Maintenance Inspections program is designed so that every foot of each rooftop is inspected, evaluated and reported on each year. This allows university officials to give approval on small fixes that are needed immediately, along with planning out for full roof replacements.

Every springtime teams of Central Roofing employees walk the rooftops of Twin Cities buildings on the East Bank, West Bank and St. Paul campuses. They remove debris, and clear all roof drains, scuppers and any other drainage discharge areas needing assistance. The teams also make notes of roofing failures, potential long-term problems and immediate needs.

Oftentimes taking up to three months to complete, the yearly inspections require precision.says Dustin Haves, previously the yendor

program coordinator for the University of Minnesota Twin Cities. "They provide the reports in a timely manner and it's easy to contact their service team if any questions arise. I personally believe this program has provided great value to the university.

"Without annual inspections the university could risk losing a warranty provided by a roof installer. This program gives the university peace-of-mind and allows for long-term planning of roof replacements."

# LESS COSTLY FOR YOUR COMPANY

hat a winter. We've had ice and snow that some of us thought might not melt until August. But it's definitely melting away and, as a result, many roofs are leaking. Does that mean it's time for a new roof? Maybe. But, maybe not.

ou may be surprised to learn that a leaky roof on a commercial building doesn't automatically mean a replacement. Instead, it may mean an inspection and a less costly Five-Year Maintenance Plan.

Here's an example. Consider a small- to mediumsized commercial building with a flat roof. The building is square, with all sides of the building straight. The rooftop area is 10,000 square feet.

A full replacement of this type of roof (without considering inflation prices due to material backorders, workforce challenges or delays) is about \$15 per square foot. Therefore, this roof will cost about \$150,000 base price to replace.

Now, let's look at another option. The owner contacts Central Roofing's Service Department. The average service call on a 10,000 square foot roof is about two hours. In that time, trained technicians

will investigate the entire roof and make a report on any found issues. They will prepare a plan of goodbetter-best options. The average fee for this service is less than \$1,000 per inspection, and most clients prefer to schedule two routine inspections per year.

Ah, but what about the roof leaks? Let's assume issues are found and fixed, with an annual cost of \$5,000 to \$10,000. Over five years, the company may spend \$25,000 to \$50,000 on different leak fixes and maintenance. That's a significant difference from the cost of an entire roof replacement at \$150,000.
